### Nadav Kander: Curves of Moon and Rivers of Blue

Award-winning photographer Nadav Kander is well known as a celebrity portrait photographer. Take "Obama's People," his record of the entirety of the 2008 Obama administration. His first solo exhibition in Hong Kong features works from two of his most celebrated photo series. "Yangtze, the Long River," features riverside landscape photos that highlight the rapid pace of change in China, and "Bodies: Six Women and One Man," is a collection of nude photographs that are honest depictions of the human form.
